

ALICE TART BUTLER BAGGETT MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

Eligible Schools: Barton College, Campbell University, UNC-Chapel Hill and Western Carolina University



INTRODUCTION

This scholarship was established in order to perpetuate the memory of Alice Tart Butler Baggett a 1933 graduate of Dunn High School after her death on January 5, 2007, by her children and their spouses, Martha Ann Butler Goff (DHS '54), Cliff Butler (DHS '64), Linda Lynch Butler (DHS '63), Robie Butler (DHS '68), and Lynda Daniel Butler.

Mrs. Baggett starred in basketball and tennis while in high school. She owned and managed Butler and Carroll Drug Store and the WCKB radio station. She was the first woman to serve on the Dunn School Board and also acted as chairman. Mrs. Baggett was a life-long member of Hood Memorial Christian Church. In addition to her children, Mrs. Baggett is survived by three grandchildren who graduated from Dunn High School, three grandchildren and four great-grandchildren who graduated from Triton High School.

THE SCHOLARSHIP

The purpose of the scholarship is to provide financial assistance to high school seniors who wish to further their education at the eligible schools. The scholarship is open to all high school senior students who meet the specific criteria. It will be awarded on an annual basis and is not renewable.

The scholarship committee may choose to interview each of the applicants. An alternate may be selected in the event the original selected student does not follow through with all the requirements. Notification of the award will be made during the designated ceremony at the school. All applications must be completed no later than the designated date set by the senior's respective high school in conjunction with DHS Friends. The payment of the scholarship will be made directly to the institution upon written verification of the student's enrollment from the school to the treasurer of DHS Friends. Each recipient will be given a scholarship verification letter at the time of the scholarship awards ceremony to present to the college registrar at the appropriate time. If the scholarship recipient should cease to attend classes at the school within the academic year, any money remaining shall be returned to the treasurer of DHS Friends.

ELIGIBILITY

The student's immediate family (mother, father, grandparents, great grandparents or other legal guardian) must have attended, taught or worked at Dunn High School

The student must provide a letter of acceptance and must plan to attend Barton College, Campbell University, UNC-Chapel Hill or Western Carolina University.

CRITERIA

The student must enroll in a full-time academic program for the fall semester of the year the scholarship is given.

The student must have a high school weighted academic GPA of 2.63 (85) or above.

The student must demonstrate academic promise, high moral character, and good citizenship. The student must also show involvement and leadership in extra-curricular activities in high school, the community, and chosen religious affiliation.

APPLICATION

Submit a signed, completed application to the local guidance department. Include at least two letters of recommendations: one from a school counselor, teacher or administrator, and one from an employer, pastor, or community leader. The guidelines and application may also be downloaded from the dhsfriends.org website.

Attach a typed essay describing a goal set and obtained (300 words or less).

Include a copy of school transcript and a non-returnable photograph (with signed release for possible publication).
