hcs COVID-19 Exclusion Summary Guidance for K-12

Exclusionary Symptoms of COVID-19 include: Fever>100.3 or chills, Cough, Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, fatigue, muscle or body aches, headache, new loss of taste or smell, sore throat, congestion or runny nose, nausea or vomiting, diarrhea

Student is not fully vaccinated and identiied as a close contact to someone who tested positive for COVID-19

If masks are not worn consistently, plan to quarantine for 10 days from the last exposure or 7 days if no symptoms are present AND the student has received results of a negative antigen OR PCR/Molecular test that was conducted NO EARLIER than Day 5 of quarantine*

Staff is not fully vaccinated and identified as a close contact to someone who tested positive for COVID-19

Plan to quarantine for 10
days from the last
exposure or 7 days if no
symptoms are present
and the staff member
has received results of a
negative antigen or
PCR/Molecular Test that
was conducted NO
EARLIER than Day 5 of
quarantine*

Student or staff has been tested for COVID-19

Student or staff should isolate and not return to school or work until results are received

> Student or staff has a negative COVID-19 test

Symptomatic students or staff who have a negative antigen (rapid) test MUST also have a negative PCR/Molecular test before returning to school/or work <u>Exposure</u> = Close contact with a case is defined as being physically exposed within 6 feet of another person for 15 minutes or longer cumulatively, within a 24 hour period

Student or staff with symptoms of COVID-19 who have visited a health care provider and received an alternate diagnosis explaining symptoms of COVID-19

Student or staff can return to school or work when it has been at least 24 hours since the person had a fever (without fever reducing medicine) and they have felt well for at least 24 hours

Student or staff has a positive COVID-19 test

Notify your school/work site and follow isolation guidance from a district health official, primary care provider or other health care official

Student or staff should plan to isolate for 10 days from the onset of symptoms or the date of a test if no symptoms are present
