Your child is currently enrolled in a high school course that requires them to take an online End of Course Exam (EOC). This exam will count for 25% of your child's final course grade. The North Carolina Department of Public Instruction requires students to participate in the EOC assessments in the school building.

Your child will be taking one of the following exams on the following date. Please make sure that your child is in attendance for each day of their exam and be on time. We will be in touch with you soon regarding if you need bus transportation for your child that day.

Furthermore, we have planned to maintain 6 feet of distance between our students in the testing rooms. Students will have temperatures taken before entering the building. Students will also be required to wear a face mask during the duration of their visit in the school building.

For the English 2 and Math 3 exams, we will have a stationary proctor in each testing room, along with a roving proctor to go between two classrooms. During the Math 1 and Biology exams, we will have two stationary proctors in the testing room.
