Your child is currently enrolled in a high school course that requires them to take an End of Course Exam (EOC). This exam will count for 25% of your child's final course grade. The North Carolina Department of Public Instruction requires students to participate in the EOC assessments in the school building. For all the exams, we will have a test administrator and proctor in each testing room.

Your child will be taking one of the following exams on the following date. Please make sure that your child is in attendance for each day of their exam and be on time. We will be in touch with you soon regarding if you need bus transportation for your child that day.

Dear Parents and Families:

High School students in Harnett County will complete the spring semester and participate in their End of Course (EOC) Online Assessments on June 2-8, 2022. These State mandated Assessments will count 25% toward your child's final course grade. The North Carolina Department of Instruction (NCDPI) requires students to participate in the EOC Assessments in the school building.

The exam grades for students enrolled in English II may be delayed up to seven days because this subject has constructed response items which require scoring by an outside vendor. Other subjects with no constructed response items will not be affected by the delay in scoring. The schools are expected to have these scores prior to the release of high school report cards.

You can help your child prepare for the assessment(s) by encouraging him or her to get plenty of rest and to eat a healthy breakfast each day prior to the test. It is also imperative that your child arrives on time for the testing session.

We also ask that you please talk with your child about leaving his/her cell phone at home during the testing window. Per the State Testing Assessment Guides, "...students are not allowed to have in their possession or to use cell phones or any other electronic devices at any time during testing, including breaks. Any person found or observed with a cell phone/electronic device during testing time must be dismissed from testing and a misadministration might be declared."

Estimados Padres y Familias:

Los estudiantes en las escuelas secundarias del Condado de Harnett completaran su semestre de primavera y participaran en las Pruebas en Línea de Fin de Curso (EOC) del 2-8 de Junio, 2022. Estas pruebas requeridas por el Estado contarán un 25% de la nota final de la clase de su hijo(a). El Departamento de Instrucción de Carolina del Norte (NCDPI) requiere que los estudiantes participen en las Pruebas EOC en el edificio escolar.

Las calificaciones del examen para los estudiantes matriculados en inglés II pueden demorarse hasta siete días porque esta asignatura tiene elementos de respuestas abiertas que requieren evaluación por un proveedor externo. Otras asignaturas que no tienen elementos de respuestas abiertas so serán afectadas por la demora de la puntuación. Las escuelas esperan tener estas calificaciones antes de la publicación de las notas de las escuelas secundarias.

Usted puede ayudar a su hijo(a) a prepararse para las pruebas animándole que tome suficiente descanso y que coma un desayuno saludable cada día antes de la prueba. También es imprescindible que su hijo(a) llegue a tiempo para la sesión de pruebas.

También le pedimos que por favor hable con su hijo(a) sobre su teléfono celular para que lo deje en casa durante el periodo de pruebas. Según el manual de pruebas estatales, "...no se les permite a los estudiantes tener en su posesión o utilizar teléfonos celulares o cualesquiera otros dispositivos electrónicos en cualquier momento durante la prueba, incluyendo los tiempos de descanso. Cualquier persona encontrada u observada con un teléfono móvil/dispositivo electrónico durante el tiempo de pruebas debe ser removido de la prueba y una mala gestión podría ser declarada."
